



## **Snowy 2.0 Work Notification**

## Talbingo | August 2021



**Activity:** Maritime exclusion zone at Lobs Hole

Location: Talbingo Reservoir, Yarrangobilly River and Tumut River
Timing: from 20 August 2021 for duration of project construction

A new pontoon at Lobs Hole has been constructed as part of the Snowy 2.0 worksite near the planned Talbingo tailrace tunnel portal.

The temporary pontoon with floating walkway extends 60m from the shoreline into the lower reach of the Yarrangobilly River in the Talbingo Reservoir.

The pontoon will be used to safely inspect the underwater pumps and cables that have been installed in the reservoir to provide a potable water supply for tunnelling activities and camp operations at Lobs Hole.

Marine plant and equipment operating in the exclusion zone during daylight hours will be marked with rotating or flashing amber lights.

Outside daylight hours and at times of restricted visibility, the marine plant and equipment will be secured within the exclusion zone and marked by a fixed white anchor light in accordance with Australian Maritime Safety Authority requirement.

The pontoon is located inside the project boundary and is approximately 16km southeast of the Talbingo boat ramp.

## Restricted access

Access to the pontoon is strictly limited to project-related vessels only.

An exclusion zone to restrict all public access is demarcated approximately 1km downstream of the worksite. Temporary yellow cardinal markers (buoys) are in place across the Yarrangobilly arm of Talbingo Reservoir, and signage will be installed on the shoreline.
