



Snowy 2.0 Work Notification

Talbingo | November 2020



Activity: Completing the installation of an underwater communication cable

Location: Talbingo boat ramp and car park, Talbingo Reservoir, Yarrangobilly River and

Tumut River

Timing: Intermittent disruptions from 2 to 30 November 2020

The installation of an underwater communication cable at Talbingo Reservoir and into the project site is nearing completion.

The remaining work and demobilising will involve some temporary disruptions that will affect access to the Talbingo boat ramp for short periods.

Work will involve

- Deliveries to the temporary compound in the car park adjacent to the boat ramp for storage and materials laydown; then demobilise the compound.
- Temporary crane operations in the car park to resupply the barge and launch from Talbingo boat ramp into reservoir; then decommission the barge.
- Barging operations along Talbingo Reservoir into the project worksite at Lobs Hole to complete the installation of a communication cable.
- A range of plant and equipment will be used such as a 20 tonne franna, barge, concrete anchors, light vehicles and semi-trailers delivering equipment and material to site.

The barge and temporary compound will be decommissioned over a period of 10-days and this will involve some temporary restrictions to the boat ramp.

What to expect

This scope of work is expected to finish by the end of November.

- The work has been planned to ensure minimal disruption for the local community, local businesses and tourism, and to minimise impact to the environment.
- Barge operations along the Yarrangobilly and Tumut Rivers.
- The barge and temporary compound will be decommissioned over a period of 10-days and this will involve some temporary restrictions to the boat ramp. The extent of this closure will be notified in more detail closer to the time.
- Traffic control will be in place during some short periods of restricted access to the boat ramp.
 Access to the boat ramp will be maintained at all other times.
- The barge will have a 30m exclusion zone and may operate 24/7. Boat users, water skiers and swimmers will need to observe the 30m exclusion zone when the barge is in operation.

Periodic updates will be issued with dates & details about the extent of restrictions to the boat ramp as the work is finalised.
