





Night closure of Sharp Street, Cooma

Monday 27 July to Friday 7 August

Temporary reconstruction of the two roundabouts in Sharp Street are required to allow large vehicles to make deliveries for Snowy 2.0.

Transport for NSW together with Future Generation will carry out work to reconstruct the roundabouts on Sharp Street at the intersections of Bombala and Vale Streets from Monday 27 July.

We will be working at night between 7pm and 5am, Sunday to Thursday. No work will be carried out during the day or Friday or Saturday nights.

Work is expected to take two weeks to complete, weather permitting.

Sharp Street will be closed during work hours between Baron Street and Soho Street. Traffic control and detours will be in place.

Footpaths will remain open at all times.

Temporary closure of Sharp Street, Cooma from Monday 27 July 2020

Transport for NSW will carry out work to two roundabouts in Sharp Street, Cooma to allow large vehicles to make essential deliveries for Snowy 2.0.

What are we doing?

We are temporarily reconstructing the roundabouts at Bombala and Vales Streets. The flower beds on the roundabouts will be removed as part of the work.

We will be working from **Monday 27 July to Friday 7 August** between **7pm and 5am, Sunday to Thursday**, weather permitting. No work will be carried out on Friday or Saturday nights.

When the Snowy 2.0 project is complete work to restore the roundabouts will be carried out.

How will the work affect you?

During the work Sharp Street will be closed between Baron Street and Soho Street. Footpaths will remain open during the work.

There will be some noise and lighting associated with this work.

We will make every effort to minimise noise for residents and complete work as quickly as possible.

This work is being carried out at night when traffic volumes are lower to reduce the impact on motorists.

Lighting will be directed away from residences where possible.

Access to properties will be maintained at all times during the work.

Motorists are advised to allow up to 5 minutes additional travel time and follow the direction of signage and traffic control.
