





Construction activities to install trunk services between Lobs Hole & Tantangara

from October 2021 to June 2022

Future Generation will install trunk services to support its construction activities and camp operations between Lobs Hole and Tantangara. The services will also be required for future operation of Snowy 2.0.

The infrastructure for electrical and communications will be installed at several Snowy 2.0 work sites and across public areas of Kosciuszko National Park from Lobs Hole to Marica and Tantangara. There are connections points to Marica Camp, the surge shaft area and Tantangara.

The services will extend from the Snowy Mountains Highway via Gooandra / Nungar / Bullocks Trails and will cross Nungar Creek to link with the Tantangara site.

Trails and camping grounds near the work will remain open to visitors in the National Park.

The trenches will generally be constructed within approved boundaries adjacent to existing roads and trails, with multiple culvert crossings and bores under some waterways.

A number of small, temporary compounds will be established along the route for storage, crew amenities and laydown areas. There will be localised restricted access to these compounds. Most of the trunk services route will not be fenced and members of the public should take care around construction activities for their personal safety.
